

Saving Money is Easy: June

Question 1: Nick earns \$71.28 per week working after school as a cashier. If he works 12 hours a week, how much does Nick earn per hour?

Answer 1: To figure this out, divide the amount of money that Nick makes per week by the amount of hours that he works. Here's how to do that:

$$\$71.28 \div 12 = \$5.94 \quad \text{Nick earns } \$5.94 \text{ per hour.}$$

Question 2: If you save \$4.00 each week for one year (52 weeks), how much money will you have?

Use the calculator to help you.

Answer 2: This one is rather easy!

$$\begin{array}{r} \$4.00 \\ \times 52 \\ \hline \$208.00 \end{array} \quad \text{You will have } \$208.00.$$

Question 3: If you save \$4.25 for 18 weeks, how much money will you have?

Use the calculator to help you.

Answer 3:

$$\begin{array}{r} \$4.25 \\ \times 18 \\ \hline \$76.50 \end{array} \quad \text{You will have } \$76.50.$$
